The key objectives of this policy are as follows:

1. Optimize energy usage and increase energy efficiency wherever possible.
2. Prevent land, air and water pollution from activities and services.

Mardyke Arena UCC is committed to protect the environment and maintaining compliance with ISO 14001:2015 Environmental Management Systems Standard, ISO 50001:2018 Energy Management Systems Standard, all relevant legislation, regulations and best practice in the area of environmental and energy management.

The Management of the Mardyke Arena UCC sets clear objectives and targets to monitor and measure both environmental and energy performance.

Our Quality Management Team are responsible for managing the environmental and energy management systems. Targets for environmental and energy management improvements are set based on continuous data analysis and monitored to achieve consistent improvement in both areas.

The following initiatives are part of the commitment to meeting our objectives and targets:

- ✓ Lighting and all high usage electrical equipment is switched off when not in use. Air-conditioning and heating is used only when necessary and at the lowest possible levels.
- ✓ Energy usage is measured and monitored on a continuous basis.
- ✓ Doors and windows are closed when air-conditioning and air handling is in operation.
- ✓ Energy efficient light bulbs are installed where possible.
- ✓ Strict controls are in place for the use of chemicals.
- ✓ Water usage is monitored.
- ✓ Internal working papers beyond use are shredded and recycled.
- ✓ Double-sided paper printing is employed whenever possible.
- ✓ Waste is segregated to dedicated bins for recycling; recycled waste is monitored.
- ✓ The company always seeks to engage with suppliers and use products that are environmentally friendly and energy efficient.
- ✓ Robust ongoing communication with stakeholders to consult on Energy and Environment matters.

Mardyke Arena UCC implements such practices wherever possible and welcomes suggestions for improvement in this area from all interested parties.

Members, patrons, and third parties are encouraged to support, whenever possible, environmentally friendly practices within the Mardyke Arena UCC.

This policy is reviewed annually as part of the Management Review Process.
